Year One Priorities (2026)

- Establish an active steering group for Pharmacy SIG
- Launch an online network map of Creative Health pharmacy projects.
- Develop one-year online programme of events, this could be quarterly related to Creative Health topics
- Scope and set up a Creative Health Pharmacy newsletter/podcast
- Provide a briefing to the Royal Pharmaceutical Society and Arts-Health APPG on the SIG's contribution to pharmacy by end of the year (Dec 2026).

Steering Group Member

- Host and manage one online event per year with support from NCCH (i.e., invite and arrange speaker)
- To arrange in person event (annually)
- Participate and contribute to SIG meetings
- Contribute to the development of the Pharmacy SIG (i.e., other events, newsletter etc)
- The steering group will comprise of students, patients, various practitioners from pharmacy and other settings
